#### 1 JURISDICTION

National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Four, Schedule Z being the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and Appendix Two, Schedule A Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements, Motorsport NZ approved articles & technical regulations applicable to the championship and Sanctioned Series Classes competing.

## **8 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING**

- The driver must hold as a minimum a National Race Grade Competition Licence.
- If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.
- Any driver who has not previously competed at the Taupo Motor Race Circuit must indicate the fact on the entry form and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. The time and place for this briefing will be detailed in Part Two of these Regulations.
- In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In Particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations. As well as Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Conduct.

## **9 DOCUMENTATION**

- Will take place in the documentation room in the pit lane complex on the day of the meeting between 7.00 am and 9.30 am

## **10 SAFETY AUDIT SCRUTINEERING**

- For vehicles that have been selected, this will take place in garage one on the day of the meeting between 7.30 am and 9.30 am Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for safety audit.
- **Safety audit scrutineering must be completed prior to qualifying and or racing.**

## **11 POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS**

- Pursuant to the National Sporting Code article 13, the organisers advise that if less than 120 entries received by the entry closing date the meeting may be postponed or cancelled.
- Should there be less than 15 entries received for any of the classes proposed in Article 7 of these Supplementary Regulations by the closing date, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that class or amalgamate it with another class at their sole discretion.

## **12 TRANSPONDER TIMING**

- Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. Should you own your own transponder you will not be liable for the \$30.00 +GST transponder hire fee.
- Lose or damage to a hire transponder will be at the hirer's expense.
- If you own your own transponder please ensure the transponder number is recorded on your entry form.

- No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly.
